## **FAMILY**

### **(First Friday of the Month)**

A family-oriented service with youth participation preceded by a dinner in the social hall. The service will be slightly shorter and we plan to include families as a 'unit' to participate in lighting the candles, lead prayers and verses etc. The sanctity of the family is a very large part of our amazing heritage, and we want to enhance the value of this Jewish tradition.



## **MUSICAL**

### **(Second Friday of the Month)**

A more musically-oriented service complete with musicians, vocalists and Jewish cheer. (In case you missed it, there is a recording of a 'Musical Shabbat' that was done during the COVID lockdown, and it contains much of the beautiful music we have grown to appreciate and enjoy.)



## **INTERFAITH**

### **(Third Friday of the Month)**

An interfaith service that includes guest ministers & parishioners from other religions. This service should be of interest to all families in which a member may not be Jewish. The goal is that your family will be drawn closer together through the joy and spirituality that Reform Judaism brings.



## **TRADITIONAL**

### **(Fourth Friday of the Month)**

A more traditional, ceremonial Shabbat service with a Torah reading and a sermon embracing the time-honored traditions of Reform Judaism. This service will be familiar to those coming from a more traditional context of Reform Jewish religious practices.
